Concrete Cleaning Compound for Floors and Heavily Oiled Spots

Description:

Concrete Cleaner is a concentrated mixture of detergents, alkaline builders and pine oils in a highly alkaline metasilicate base for use in cleaning heavily oiled concrete surfaces of all types. It may also be used in dilute form to clean less heavily oiled or greasy concrete.

Directions For Use:

Service Bays, Driveways and Parking Areas - Wet area to be cleaned and lightly sprinkle cleaner over entire surface; agitate with a broom or deck brush and allow to remain on the surface for 8 to 10 minutes. Hose off with clean water. Uncovered areas are best done during light rain.

Restaurants - Concrete Cleaner should be used as above in areas with floor drains such as cook area and prep area floors where grease build-up is a problem. Product may also be dissolved in water at a rate of 2 to 8 oz. per gallon of warm water for use as a mopping solution. Rinse mop with clean cold water.
